Re: **DECISION CONCERNING QUALIFIED TEAMS FOR 2015 WORLD CUP & 2016 OLYMPIC GAMES**

Dear Sirs / Madams

Refer to the decision of AVC Board of Administration's Extra Ordinary Meeting in Bangkok on 3rd December 2014 to nominate a group of Board of Administration Members, consisted of Mr. Shanrit Wongprasert, Mr. Cai Yi, Mr. Craig Carracher, Mr. Davarzani, Dr. Han Joo Eom and Dr. Yuichiro Hamu to consider the qualified teams for 2015 World Cup and 2016 Olympic Games both Men and Women.

After carefully consideration and discussion, the decision of the nominated group are approved and will be applied for the above 2 qualifications championships :-

2015 World Cup

The best two World Ranking teams of Asia as of 1st January 2015 will qualify to 2015 Men and Women World Cup in Japan because the competition schedule of AVC and FIVB in 2015 is very tight. If the teams know their schedule early, the preparation of the teams will be better. If the teams from Asia can qualify to 2016 Olympic Games through the World Cup, Asia will have more qualified teams to 2016 Olympic Games.

2016 Olympic Games

Because the schedule of the competition is not tight, the teams will have enough time for their preparation. So the ranking of 18th Asian Sr. Men and Women Championship will be considered. The best three teams and Japan as the organizer will have the right to participate 2016 Asian and World Olympic Qualifications in Japan in May 2016.

Your keen attention to the above decision of the mentioned Extra Ordinary Meeting of AVC Board of administration will be very highly appreciated.
